



Nauti Girls Fishing Tournament Rules

DATE: 3 June, 2023

FISHING: This is an ANGLER TOURNAMENT. Federal, State & County Fishing laws apply to each angler that chooses to compete in this tournament.

ENTRY FEE: Entry fee is \$40.00 per angler.

CAPTAIN'S MEETING: Will be held on June 2, 2023 at the Steinhatchee Marina at Deadman Bay - 104 First Ave SW, Steinhatchee starting at 6 pm.

SAFETY: SAFETY IS ALWAYS FIRST. Safety is paramount. Captains are responsible for the safe and legal operation of their boats at all times. Captains are reminded that they should have an operational VHF radio on board their boat for safety. VHF radio Channels 9&10 are monitored by the local marinas. Fishing begins at safe light. There is no check in or check out.

QUALIFYING FISH: Fish eligible for this tournament are Redfish, Trout, Cobia, and King Mackerel. Fish must be caught on hook and line and landed in whole condition. Fish must be of legal length, bag & possession limits. Weighing of a fish that is not within legal limits will result in disqualification from the ENTIRE tournament. In case of a tie, the earliest fish weighed will win. Mutilated fish will not be weighed.

WEIGH-IN: Weigh-in opens 1 pm on 3 June 2023 at Steinhatchee Marina at Deadman Bay. Weigh-in will close for all anglers at 5:30 pm. All anglers weighing fish **MUST** have their ticket with them. **You must be in line with your fish and ticket by 5:30pm.**

AWARDS: Prize structure for this tournament is as follows:

Redfish –	1 st \$800,	2 nd \$400,	3 rd \$200
Trout –	1 st \$800,	2 nd \$400,	3 rd \$200
Cobia -	1 st \$800,	2 nd \$400,	3 rd \$200
King Mackerel -	1 st \$800,	2 nd \$400,	3 rd \$200
Mystery fish – Black Sea Bass	Gift card of \$100		

*Redfish with the most spots - \$200.00 (*The winning redfish with the most spots counted on both sides of the fish's body. Spots must be separated to count. Spots that are not separated, irregular or misshaped will count as one spot. The weigh master's count is final.)

PROTESTS: The Tournament Committee will settle any Protest. The Tournament Committee's decision is FINAL
